## PROFILE

NORDEUROPAforum was founded in 1991 as a magazine and has been published as a purely academic journal since 1998. Since 2013, it has carried the subtitle »Journal for the Study of Culture«.

As a double peer-reviewed open access journal, NORDEUROPAforum deals with the European North from a cultural studies perspective.

We publish articles, reviews, conference reports, and blog posts in German and English, covering the entire region: Denmark, Sweden, Norway, Finland, and Iceland, and also Greenland and the Faroe Islands, the Baltic States, Northwest Russia, Northern Germany, Poland, and their transregional connections.

As an interdisciplinary journal, our publications cover a wide range of approaches, from literature and linguistics to sociology, anthropology, medieval studies, history, and political science, and also media, film and art studies—although this list is by no means to be understood as exclusive.

## QUALITY ASSURANCE

Each paper submitted to NORDEUROPAforum is evaluated carefully. The internal review is followed (when positive) by a double-blind peer review. The text is then edited in close consultation with the author.

## OPEN ACCESS

Since 2006, NORDEUROPAforum has been published exclusively as an open access publication (CC BY 4.0) on the Internet. This type of publication guarantees authors and readers free and public access to academic research. Our contributions are easy to access, can be shared and cited without restrictions. The copyright of the authors remains unaffected.

The publications appear in continuous succession. All publications can be retrieved individually. They are permanently stored on the edoc server of the Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin.

## NORDEUROPAforum BLOG

In our blog articles, members of the journal's editorial team and guest authors comment on the political,

cultural, and academic life of Northern Europe, spread the word about new publications and events, and report and reflect on their own work.

The blog contributions of NORDEUROPAforum appear on the Nordeuropa-Blog, which is run jointly with vifanord.

## EDITORIAL
